BLS certification required.

Complete nurse aide certificate program.

Maintain active status in nurse aide registry in the state of Texas.

One year experience in a medical setting preferred.

Nursing Assistant course desirable.

Intermittent sitting, prolonged periods of standing and walking. Frequent bending, stooping, and reaching. Average lifting of 25# from the floor to waist, 50# from 30" high surface to surface, 15# overhead. Pushing and pulling with 50# force while assisting patients or moving equipment. Includes all physical tasks as outlined in the discipline's respective practice act.
