

**A RESOLUTION LEVYING TAXES FOR THE USE AND SUPPORT
OF GONZALES HEALTHCARE SYSTEMS FOR
MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION FOR THE YEAR 2020**

BE IT RESOLVED by the GONZALES HEALTHCARE SYSTEMS Board of Directors.

Section 1. That there is hereby levied and there shall be collected for the use and support of GONZALES HEALTHCARE SYSTEMS to provide revenue for maintenance and operation for the year 2020 upon all property, real, personal and mixed, within the boundaries of said District subject to taxation, a tax of \$ 0.3095 hundredths cents on each One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) valuation of the property, said tax being so levied for the maintenance and operation and support of GONZALES HEALTHCARE SYSTEMS.


THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 5.10 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$15.80.

Section 2. All monies collected under this Resolution for the specific items herein named, shall be and the same are hereby appropriated and set apart for the specific purposes of maintenance and operation, and the Assessor and Collector of taxes and the District's Secretary shall keep these accounts so as to readily and distinctly show the amounts collected, and the amounts expended, and the amount on hand at any time, belonging to such funds. It is hereby made the duty of the Tax Assessor and Collector of taxes and every person collecting money for GONZALES HEALTHCARE SYSTEMS to deliver to the District's Secretary at the time of depositing any monies, a statement showing such deposit and from what source received.


Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passing.
