Precautions we are taking to ensure YOUR safety.



Screening Procedures

All patients, visitors, and staff are being screened prior to entering our facility.

Both temperatures and symptoms are being checked.



Face Mask Protection

We are requiring all patients, visitors, and staff wear a mask at all times while in the facility.



Social Distancing

Please stay at least 6 feet apart from other people in any area of our facility.



Best Hygiene Practices

Wash hands or use hand sanitizer regularly. Cover any coughs or sneezes with a tissue and discard.

We have updated our visitor policy, effective AUGUST 3, 2021.

VISITORS WILL NOT be allowed into our facilities, with the following <u>exceptions:</u>

- OB: 1 care partner for the duration of the stay.
- **Inpatient:** 1 adult only if it is necessary to the patient's care, or if the patient is a minor.
- Outpatient: 1 adult, only if patient is a minor, an OB patient presenting for an ultrasound appt., or that is necessary to the patient's care.
- ER: 1 adult only if it is necessary to the patient's care, or if the patient is a minor.
- **SMC:** 1 adult if it is necessary to the patient's care, or if the patient is a minor.
- For OR patients, the nurse and doctor will call a family member with updates, and at time of discharge.
- For patients at end of life, visitors limited at the charge nurse's discretion.
- Visitors **WILL NOT** be permitted for COVID positive patients, or possible COVID positive patients. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Visiting hours are 7am-7pm. Approved visitors may enter thru the Outpatient Entrance from 7am-5pm. After 5pm, approved visitors are asked to enter and exit through the Emergency department.
