

Registered Nurse

As an associate of Gonzales Healthcare Systems, you will have the opportunity to provide direct nursing care to patients in accordance with established policies, procedures, and protocols of the healthcare organization. The RN will:

- **Implement and monitor patient care plans. Monitor, record, and communicate patient condition as appropriate.**
- **Serves as a primary coordinator of all disciplines for well-coordinated patient care.**
- **Notes and carries out physician and nursing orders.**
- **Assesses and coordinates patient's discharge planning needs with members of the healthcare team.**

BLS, ACLS, and PALS credentialed from the American Heart Association; ACLS and PALS to be obtained within 6 months of date of hire or transfer; TNCC required within one year of date of hire or transfer for ER RN or Med-Surg Charge Nurse.

Graduate of an accredited school of professional nursing (GN) obtained prior to start date or job transfer date is required -OR- Temporary or Current Registered Nurse (RN) license to practice in the state of Texas is required or must be obtained prior to hire or job transfer date –OR- current home state license for multi-state license recognition through the Nurse Licensure Compact is required or must be obtained prior to hire or job transfer date.
