Functions under the direct supervision of an Occupational Therapist to provide safe and effective patient treatments as assigned by the Occupational Therapist. Documents treatments provided and progress of the patient toward set goals. Notifies Occupational Therapist of any adverse reactions to treatment and of any possible changes needed in treatment.

Graduate of an accredited Associates Degree program for Occupational Therapy Assistants. Texas Occupational Therapy Assistant License and a valid Texas Driver's License required.

No prior work experience required. Effective oral and written communication abilities and organizational skills. Current CPR Certification required.
